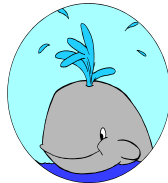

Policy Reminder

Parents, for the safety and health of your children, please take this opportunity to review the policies in place to protect your children from spreading or contracting possible contagious illnesses. As stated in our Parent Handbook: If your child shows any symptoms of illness that would prevent comfortable participation in activities including outdoor play, please keep him/her at home. This includes fever, productive cough, rashes, diarrhea, vomiting, colored or heavy nasal discharges, or other illnesses, which might affect the health of other students and our teachers. We wish to keep all our students and teachers well! If your child is ill and has a fever (fever—oral 100.4 rectal 101.4, armpit 99.4, ear 100.4) within 24 hours before Day School, please keep him/her at home. Your child may return when a medical evaluation by a health-care professional indicates the child is able to be included in the Day School activities or no signs/symptoms of illness or fever have been present for 24 hours.
