As Autumn swoops in and summer fades away, our children begin to notice the changing colors in the world around them. Our little ones start identifying colors while our older kids learn creative

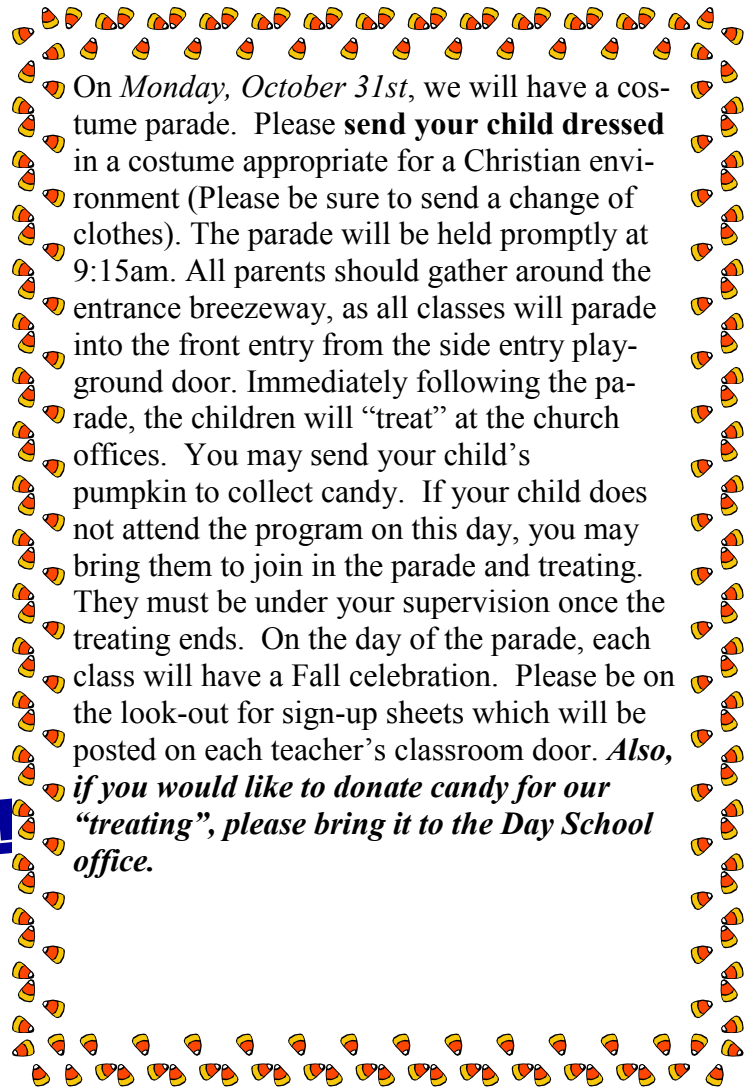

MONDAY, OCTOBER 10TH COLUMBUS DAY CLOSURE

The Day School will be closed on Monday, Oct 10th in observance of Columbus Day. Holiday Care will be offered on this day for all registered children who sign up in advance. There is a form in each classroom you must fill out and return to the office no later than Friday, September 30th in order for your child to be accepted into care on this day.

PARENT REMINDER: Please remember children in Pre K must be there by the scheduled start time of their class as to not interrupt the classroom learning environment with a late arrival.



On *Monday, October 31st*, we will have a costume parade. Please **send your child dressed** in a costume appropriate for a Christian environment (Please be sure to send a change of clothes). The parade will be held promptly at 9:15am. All parents should gather around the entrance breezeway, as all classes will parade into the front entry from the side entry playground door. Immediately following the parade, the children will “treat” at the church offices. You may send your child’s pumpkin to collect candy. If your child does not attend the program on this day, you may bring them to join in the parade and treating. They must be under your supervision once the treating ends. On the day of the parade, each class will have a Fall celebration. Please be on the look-out for sign-up sheets which will be posted on each teacher’s classroom door. *Also, if you would like to donate candy for our “treating”, please bring it to the Day School office.*
